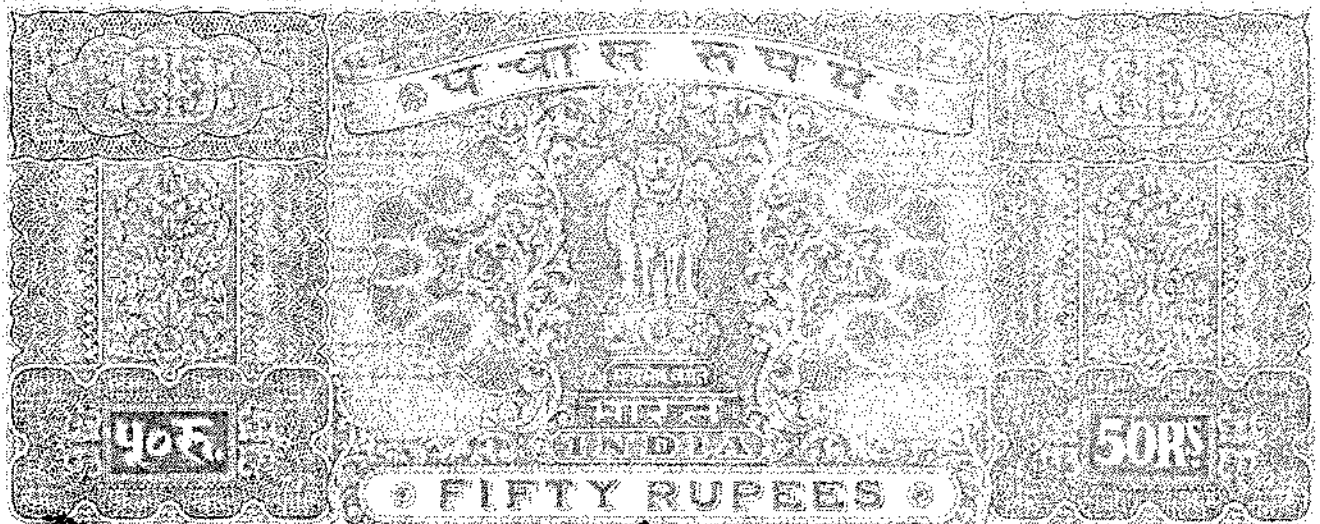

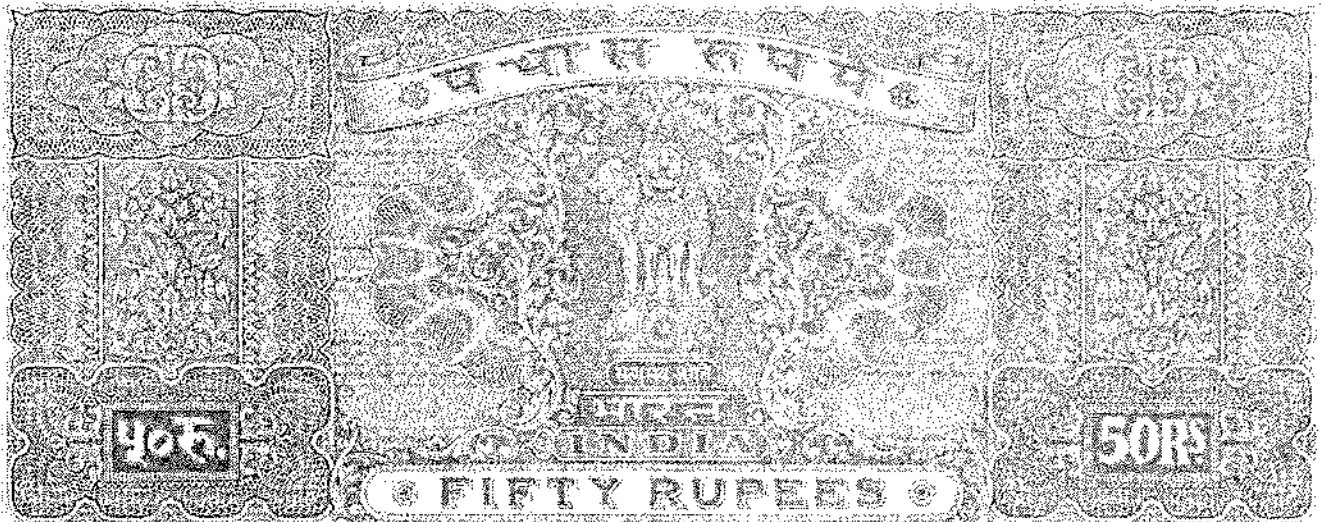

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2. The Registered Office of the Trust shall be as at present at 590/15, Rajapalayam Road, Chatrapatti-626102.

3. The objects for which the Trust is formed are;

- (a) to relieve the poor, the indigent persons irrespective of caste, creed, religion or nationality and provide for their bare necessities of life.
- (b) to start establish, maintain and take over dispensaries, chemical laboratories and other allied institutions and hospitals.
- (c) to provide medical relief freely or at subsidised rates to the needy poor.
- (d) to arrange for relief operations to the affected in case of riots, natural calamities and drought and arrange for rehabilitation work
- (e) to provide and establish, run and take over water booths and bunks wherever and whenever necessary.

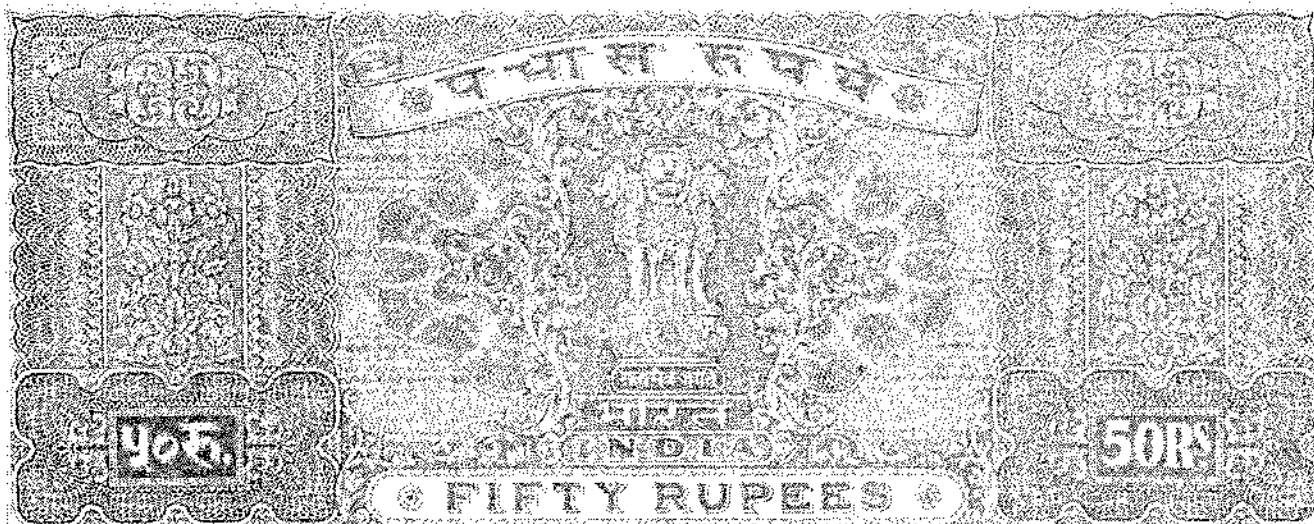

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(f) to establish maintain manage, run, develop, sponsor, schools, colleges, research institutions, universities, polytechnics, professional institutions and industrial schools.

(g) to institute, establish, run, take on lease or otherwise and maintain libraries, reading rooms (mobile or otherwise)

(h) to construct, start, run, maintain and take over and develop homes, feeding house for the aged orphans destitutes, women, working women, and creches.

(i) to inculcate education, including general, commercial, technical, technological and professional through institutions from pre-school level upto the University level.

(j) to establish, maintain, take over and support, medical schools, colleges and other similar institutions for the advancement of research in medicines, allopathic, siddha, homeopathic, Ayurvedic, Unani and other branches and systems with particular reference to the development of life saving drugs or medicines.

(k) to start, run and manage small scale industries for the purpose of providing the Rural folk and women folk part-time employment.

(l) to start, establish take over and manage small scale industries, for the said purpose.

(m) to promote religious and spiritual values and for the said purpose arrange for discourses, symposiums, performances, excursions and Tours.

(n) to render social service and conduct Guidance Bureau during festivals and Melas.

(o) to propagate against and combat with the evil of dowry and child marriages and arrange, organise and conduct and encourage austerity in marriages, group marriages and give donations for each such marriages.

4. The income and property of the Trust whenever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Trust as set forth in this Deed and no payment shall be paid directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise in whatsoever manner and howsoever, by way of profit to the Founders of the Trust.

5. TRUST BOARD: a) The Board of Trustees of this Trust shall not be less than 2 but not more than 10, the first Founder Trustees herein shall hold office in each one of the individual's life time. The Trustees wherein shall have power to co-opt additional trustees not exceeding 10 inclusive of the existing trustees.

(b) The office of the trustees shall be vacated if a trustee permanently leaves India or is absent for 3 (three) consecutive meetings of the Trust Board without obtaining leave of absence of his absence from India for a period exceeding six months or if he/she expresses his/her unwillingness to continue or upon death, insanity, resignation, insolvency, refusal or unable to act as a trustee or on becoming incapable to act as a trustee. vacancy may be filled up by other trustees but subject always to the maximum and minimum number of trustees mentioned in clause (a) above. The persons appointed or co-opted as trustees in the aforesaid manner shall hold office during his or her life time with all rights and duties as of the original trustees but subject to removal, resignation etc., hereunder provided under sections 31 To 54 of the Indian Trusts Act.

(c) The remaining Trustees may continue to act, notwithstanding any vacancy in their body, so long as their number is not reduced below the minimum of two stipulated above.

(d) Upon the appointment of the new trustee as aforesaid or by appointment, such new trustees shall have the same powers, authorise and discretions, as if they had been originally appointed as a Trustee to these presents.

(e) without prejudice to any other provisions of law, a Trustee of the said law and Act shall stand discharged from his/her office of trustees upon his/her tendering his/her resignation as a trustee, in writing to the aforesaid Trust of the Trust office and to all other Trustees or on the happening of any of the events mentioned in clause (b) above.

(f) The Trustees herein shall elect among themselves of office bearers; as Managing Committee.

(a) PRESIDENT/SECRETARY : A. ARUMUGHAM
(b) TREASURER : A. PALANIGURU

The above mentioned persons shall be the first batch of Office bearers.

6. Any number of trustees in excess of the aforesaid office bearers shall be deemed to be ordinary trustees. The said office bearers the President, Secretary, and Treasurer shall hold office for a period of 3 years and on the expiry of the said 3 years or by resignation or by any other causes mentioned above, if any office falling vacant, the same shall be filled in by means of election from the trustees and in the case of such casual vacancies the future incumbent shall hold office for the balance period of the outgoing trustee would have continued.

exchange or admit consideration and set the documents registered, if necessary and do other things incidental thereto.

(c) To take, or give on lease or otherwise management run institutions organisations with identical or allied objects above mentioned and give assistance (financial or otherwise) to them.

(d) To mortgage, hypothecate or pledge or create charge or lien on all or any of the properties (movables and immovables) of the trust for the purpose of obtaining funds, loans, advances, from whatever source available and to do and execute all or any of the acts and things and deeds deemed necessary for the above said purposes.

(e) To organise and stage dramas, cultural tours, screen cinemas, film shows, festivals, puppet shows, benefit meetings and other performances for the purpose of collecting donations to meet the expenses to be incurred for the objects of the Trust.

(f) Construction of houses, huts, dwellings etc., for the poor and needy.

9. PRESIDENT:- The President of the Trust shall preside over the meetings of the Office bearers and also the trustees. The President/Treasurer individually in his/her capacity as President/ and Treasurer respectively shall have the individual power to open, operate and close Bank Accounts of any nature and shall be entitled to execute any deeds, instruments, Cheques, Bill of exchange etc., on behalf of the trust apart from the powers vested to Secretary and Treasurers. The President shall not exercise his/her vote unless it has become necessary for him/her to exercise a casting vote. The President or any other office bearer is also liable to be removed by means of a resolution of 'No Confidence' passed by the Trust Board by 2/3rd majority of the trustees present on giving an opportunity to be heard why he shall not be removed. This provision as to the removal from office will be applicable to all office bearers of the Trust Board.

10. SECRETARY:- The Secretary of the Trust shall be in charge of the day-to-day administration of the Trust and shall be the person to use or to be used on behalf of the Trust. The Secretary, has the power to appoint, suspend or dismiss any employee for any reason or reasons subject to approval of the Managing Committee. President shall be the competent person to sign agreements and contracts for the Trust.

11. TREASURER: The Treasurer of the Trust shall be entitled individually to sign Cheques and other papers in respect of the Bank transactions and shall also be entitled to sign or execute any deed of mortgage, hypothecation, charge etc., in dealing with the finances of the Trust.

12. INVESTMENTS OF FUNDS OF THE TRUST: Such of the persons of the funds of the Trust that are not required for the day-to-day administration of the Trust shall be invested in approved securities or in any other nationalised banks or in any mode provided in the Trusts act for the purpose or investing or deciding the terms and conditions or investment, the resolution of the Trust Board is necessary.

13. INSPECTION OF BOOKS OF ACCOUNTS OF THE TRUST BY A MEMBER OF THE TRUST - GIVING INTIMATION OF SUCH A MOVE TO THE TRUST OFFICE :-

It is open for any member of the Trust Board to have access to the Books of Accounts (which will have to be kept available as provided under Sec.17 of the trusts act) at any reasonable time on giving prior intimation to the Trust Office.

14. APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT AND RULES FRAMED THEREUNDER:

For such of the needs for which no provision is made herein so far as the provisions herein are not repugnant to the provision of the Trust Act - the Trust Act and the rules framed thereunder shall be deemed applicable to the Trust.

15. LITIGATION JURISDICTION:

For the purpose of jurisdiction, the Magistrate/Sub-Magistrate Civil Court at Srivilliputtur will be deemed to be the Courts having jurisdiction to entertain and try the litigation.
